This letter responds to your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request dated and received by the Office of the Director of National Intelligence (ODNI) on 1 March 2022, in which you sought "...records pertaining to the sighting and operation of unidentified drones (or UAS, UAV) in the vicinity of US Navy ships (including but not limited to the USS Kidd, USS Omaha, USS Rafael Peralta, USS Russell, USS John Finn...) in the SOCAL OPAREA military range off California in July and August 2019."

Upon review, your request appears to be connected to Unidentified Aerial Phenomena (UAP) activity. While ODNI, in consultation with the Secretary of Defense, wrote a report on UAP as directed by the Intelligence Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2021, the Director, Department of Defense Unidentified Aerial Phenomena Task Force (UAPTF) is the official responsible for collection and consolidation of source data on UAP. Therefore, ODNI recommends you submit your request directly to DoD to ensure the most efficient handling. As such, we are administratively closing your case.

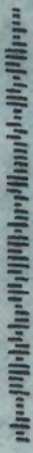

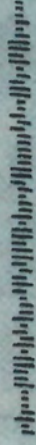

Mr. Karvanek:

This letter responds to your Freedom of Information Act ("FOIA") requests dated 17 October 2022 and received by the Office of the Director of National Intelligence (ODNI) on 8 November 2022, in which you requested, respectively:

DF-2023-00031: "...UFOs and UAP Research independent of the Dods UFOs and USOs USN Investigation F-18s FLIR videos Tic-Tak, GAMBAL, Go Fast that were released by Dir AATIP Louis Elexando to the American publics via FOIA Act."

DF-2023-00032: "...documents 37 US Navy Range Fouler Reports 11 Near collisions in SOCAL MOA and WISKY-72 any and all UAP USODI&SJ UAP PA, 2021 Tic-Tak, GIMBAL, Go Fast videos on a Dvd USS Russell UAP video, 2019 USS Omaha video."

Both of your requests were processed under the FOIA, 5 U.S.C. § 552, as amended. For DF-2023-00031, no records were located as our agency conducted no independent research on Unidentified Aerial Phenomena (UAP). For DF-2023-00032, your request is asking for source documentation, records which are owned by another federal agency. You should submit your request directly to DoD as the Director, Department of Defense Unidentified Aerial Phenomena Task Force (UAPTF) as they are responsible for the collection and consolidation of data on UAP. Were ODNI to locate any of the source documentation in our files, we would refer those document to that agency. As ODNI does not possess any ODNI-originated records responsive to DF-2023-00032, we are administratively closing your case.

If you are not satisfied with my response to your request, you may administratively appeal by submitting a written request to the Chief FOIA Officer, c/o Chief, Information Management Office, Office of the Director of National Intelligence, Washington, DC 20511 or dni-foia@dni.gov. The request letter and envelope or subject line of the email should be marked "Freedom of Information Act Appeal." Your appeal must be postmarked or electronically transmitted within 90 days of the date of this letter.
