Dear Mr. Zafar,

This letter is a supplemental response to your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request dated 21 November 2018 and received by the Information Management Division (IMD) of the Office of the Director of National Intelligence (ODNI) on 27 November 2018, in which you requested “Inspector general reports dated on or after June 1, 2015, concerning surveillance conducted pursuant to 50 U.S.C. § 1861 or 50 U.S.C. §§ 1841-1846” among other things.

On June 20, 2019, IMD issued its final response to you, releasing one document in full, withholding one document in full, referring twenty-eight (28) documents to other agencies for direct response, and referring you to the publicly-available locations of five documents. Since then, we made a discretionary decision to re-process the document that was previously withheld in full. Accordingly, that document is now being produced to you with redactions pursuant to the following FOIA exemptions:

- (b)(1), which applies to information that is currently and properly classified pursuant to Executive Order 13526, Section 1.4 (c);
- (b)(3), which applies to information exempt by statutes; the specific statute applicable to this case is: 50 U.S.C. § 3024(i)(1), which protects intelligence sources and methods;
- (b)(7)(E), which applies to techniques and procedures for law enforcement investigations or prosecutions.
